

Interstate 70 at Wentzville Parkway

Project Facts:

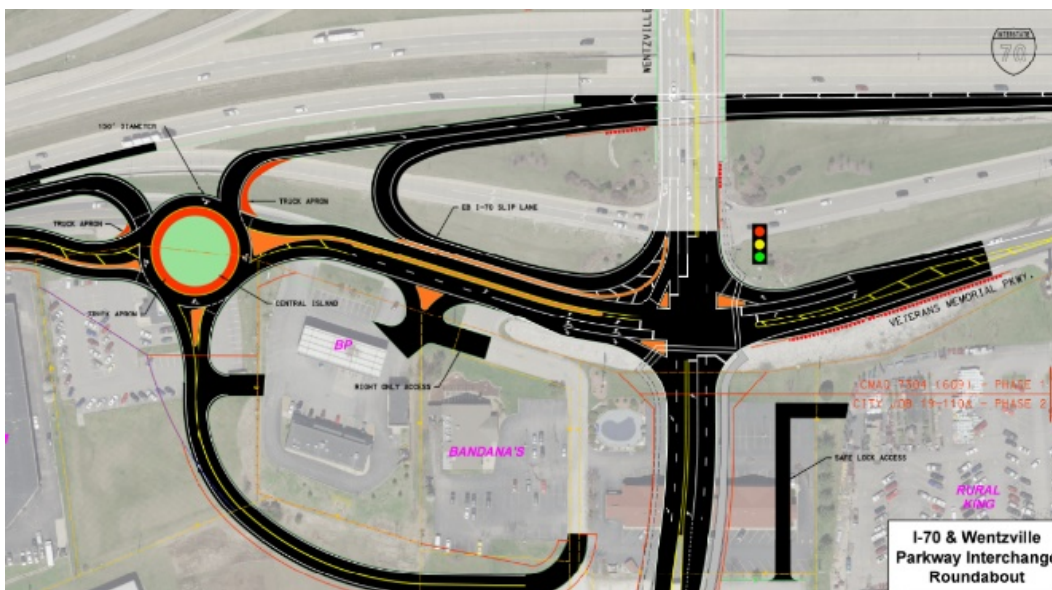
- Phase 1 – Interchange Improvements
 - Free flow southbound to eastbound I-70 movement
 - New roundabout on Veterans Memorial Parkway for eastbound I-70 movements
 - Signal improvements at Wentzville Parkway and Veterans Memorial Parkway
 - Estimated phase 1 project cost: \$4.6 million
- Phase 2 – Southern Extension
 - South extension of Wentzville Parkway from Veterans Memorial Parkway to Interstate Dr.
 - New bridge over Norfolk Southern Railroad
 - Two lane roadway initially, designed to be expanded to four lanes.
 - Upon completion, close Wilmer Road at-grade railroad crossings.
 - Hepperman Road crossing being studied for potential future closing.
 - Estimated phase 2 project cost: \$6.5 million

Project Benefits:

- Reduce delays and congestion by 50% at Wentzville Parkway and Eastbound I-70 ramps
- Reduce number of expected crashes along Wentzville Parkway
- Construct new grade separated railroad overpass and close two at-grade crossings.

Project Timeline:

- Phase 1 Construction - 2021
- Phase 2 Construction – 2022
- Project Completed by Spring 2023



New roundabout will allow for improved access to eastbound I-70 and reduce delays at Wentzville Parkway and Veterans Memorial Parkway
